McLochland was getting him into cover when he died in his arms. That was in the 1st August stunt. I am certain of that because McLochland told me, and then got killed in the last stunt.

(known as Charlie Chaplin) were killed together at Monquet

Farm on Sept. 3rd while digging in. As we came back for cover
again I was asking about Charlie Chaplin, and was told that
the four men were working together when a shell blew them
all up. I cannot remember who it was that told me, but
it can be depended upon. We were all in the same reinforce-
ments so we were very particular about finding out about
each other. It was one of our lot who told me.
