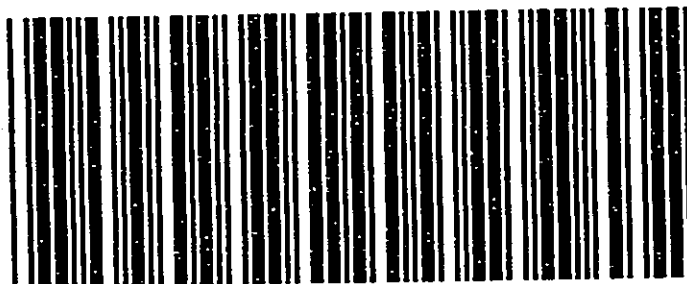

Informant states that "on April 11th at pullecourt Shaw was taken prisoner. This was told by Lt. Wilkins, 15th A.I.F., who was then in this Hcsept., as a patient in F. ward. It was also reported so in Battalion Orders. I had belonged to D. Coy.
