

Informant and "Tom" Medden were both wounded on the same day. Informant saw the stretcher-bearerscarrying him away. He had been severely wounded in the head by a fragment of high explosive shell. This was on let November, near Combles -- about a mile from Bepaume.

Madden was short, thick-set, young, dark, and had been

an engine-driver.

Madden was wounded on the 31/12/16 near Montauban on the Somme in the head. He was taken to Anzac Dressing Station and then on to 36th Casualty Clearing Station, where he died on the 28/11/16. He is buried in a British Cemetery at Heilley.
