

Informant states casualty was 5 ft.5, medium dark, nuggety build, clean shaven. Casualty came from Zeehan, Tasmania originally. Casualty went out with Crane and Lonegan of the same battalion on the 25th day of April, the day of the landing, and was reported missing. All the boys are positive that informant asked, that casualty is a prisoner in the hands of the Turks.
