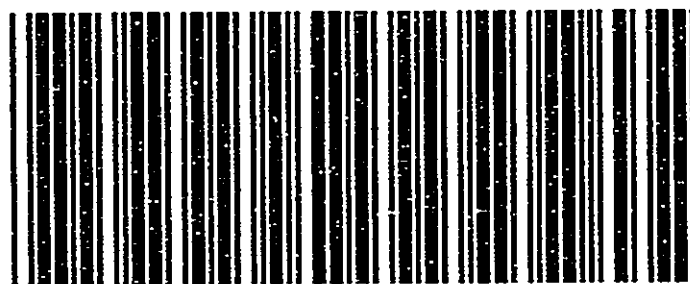

I didn't see Moore: B.Co. and Bill Martin, C.Co. killed by aeroplane bomb at Tincourt near the Y.M.C.A. when they had been getting a drink of tea. It happened at nighttime. Thirteen dead bodies were found next morning I don't know in what parts of the bodies they were hit. I don't know about burial. There was another T.W. Martin in the Coy whom he used to call Tommy (he was in the Scouts and had 2 decorations - he was killed by shell fire at Roisel a few days before the bomb casualty).

MOORE. W.H. - Red Hair, med. Hgt. abt. 22yrs.

Martin - "Bill", Fairly tall, dark, abt. 26 yrs. I think he came from Ballarat.
