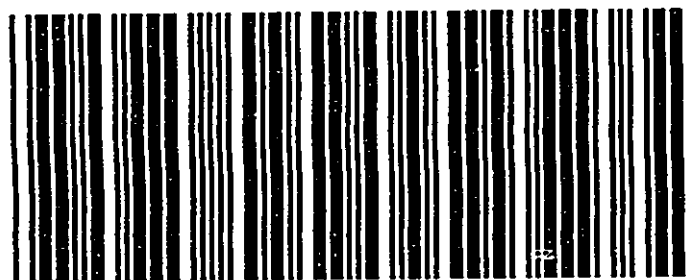

"Missing July 20th 1916."

At Fleurbaix on July 20th out in No Man's Land I saw Robinson's body he was killed by a bullet in the head scarcely a spec of blood, he was lying beside me I knew him quite well. I was out then for 13 or 14 hours
