## "Killed 11th April, 1917."

"Of C. Coy., on 11th April, at Bullicourt. I did not see him killed, but I saw his pay book which had been taken from him by a man in 15th Batn., whose name I cannot remember. His book had a bullet hole right through it and was covered with blood. This man told me that Ryan was killed outright, shot through the heart. His body was left on the field.

I He told the man who had the pay book to hand it over to one of our Officers who was in the P/W Yard; where we were collected.
