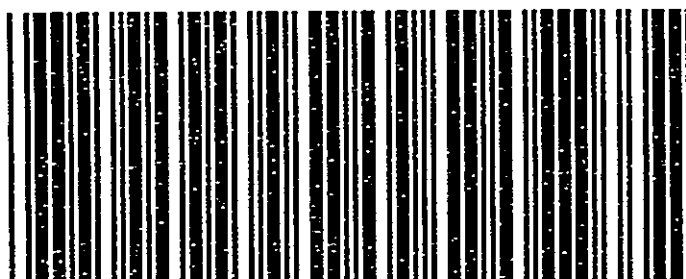

I knew casualty, he was a man of slim build, 5'5" in height, dark complexion, about 30 years of age. Casualty was at Passchendaele during the advance. He was cook and was in the cook house when a high explosive shell landed near by and killed him instantly. I do not know where he was buried.

At Glencorse Wood. I saw him wounded in the face but it did not seem very serious. This was in a shell hole back in the support lines. I knew him well, we came over from Aust: together.

He was in B.Coy., a single man, a short fair man, about 22. I saw him last wounded walking back to the D/Station at Ypres during the daytime, under heavy shell fire and nothing more has ever been heard of him. We retained the ground.

I knew casualty, he was a man of stout build, 5'6" in height, fair complexion, about 26 years of age. Casualty was in Polygon Wood Supports on a little sap. He was standing about fifty yards from where I was when a high explosive shell landed near him, when I looked again he could not be seen. I believe he was buried by the shell.
