I was in the same ward with him at Valenciennes Hospital He had his leg amputated and was slo suffering from frostbite and dysentery. I used often to speak to him and he told me about his wife and four children. I was sitting by his bedside when he died at about 5.30.ap.m. (about June 1917) A minister had given him the sacrament about half an hour before. He had a series of operations but I don't think he would have died if he had been treated properly. His name was Alfred and he was a fair man of about 45 in 12th A.I.F.
