"Died as Prisoner of War at Valenciennes" 2.6.17.

I was in the same ward with him at Valenciennes Hospital. He had his leg amputated and was also suffering from frostbite and dysentery. I used often to speak to him and he told me about his wife and four children. I was sitting by his bedside when he died at about 5.30.p.m. (about June 1917). A minister had given him the sacrament about half an hour before. He had a series of operations but I don't think he would have died if he had been treated properly. His name was Alfred and he was a fair man of about 45 in 14th A.I.F.

17th Sept. 19.

It is hereby certified that there is here the death card of the Ref. II.D., according to which the Australian Prisoner of War Muller, Alfred, 14th Bn, Australian Imperial Forces, 4th Brigade, 4th Division died at Valenciennes on 2nd June 1917 and was buried in the Cemetery of Honour at Valenciennes R. Grave 13.
