I know Pt. Con Mulligan of D.Co. He was tall, thin, and about 21 years of age. He came over in the 1st to 22nd reinforcement. I saw him lying dead about 20 or 30 yards from a pill-box on October 4th, after the attack. I was coming back with a prisoner. He was quite dead. I recognised him easily. I do not know if he was buried. He held this ground.
