The Germans were attacking at Hermies and he came up with a party to reinforce cur post, but they missed us and got into No Man's Land. He was hit by a rifle bullet, but as they were between cur fire and the Germans', it is impossible to say which he was hit by. His body was about 60 yards from cur post and we could see it during the daytime, but it was note recovered. A few nights later a lot of bodies, including many Germans' were buried, but there was no record made of his burial. It was about 4.e.m. on 15th April 1917. 15th April 1917.
