

I left Melbourne on S.S.Warilda February 8th 1916.

with a Jim Morrissey - who had been at Gallipoli and had rejoined. I was with him in France. He was a Sergeant. I got knocked November 11th 1916 and can remember nothing about Morrissey, on August 26th 1916. - I met Cple(Battn 21. Coy A.98th Reinforcements) at Horseferry Road, about month again ago. He told me that Morrissey had returned to Australia. He was elederly, tall, ckean shaven, medium build.
