With reference to your enquiry, this man died of wounds on August 2nd 1917 at 12.45 p.m. He was admitted to the 3rd Canadian Casualty Clearing Station, France, suffering from gunshot wound chest penetrating on July 30th and died on Aug. 2nd. He is buried in the Lyssenthoek Cemetery Belgium and his grave is marked 16 J 18.
