He was in B Co. Signallers. I was told by Pto.T.Callboy 28th A.I.F. B Co. Signallers that at Fozieres on the 29th July whene we were attacking the German first line a shell blew up a group and Minett was emongsthem. I caw Callboy afterwards about 10th Rov.; he was wounded in the arm and went to a hospital at Staples and I heard that he was afterwards sent to a hospital in England. He could give full information.
