

Witness knew Michell well. He was about 20 years of age, was connected with the profes ion of dentistry, and was member of the Frd reinforcements of the battm. His number was about 1500. He was wounded at the landing by a bullat in the chast. Ditness did not see the occurrence but Hichell told him of it. Subsequently he was wounded in the neck at Lone Fine. Witness saw him at hospital Luns Fark and actually wan the wound. Michell was temporarily on the staff from Aug. to Dec. 1915 and Rof:- Pto A. B. Poroy. 1495. Quotter wan See report from C Co. 53 A. I. F.
Tel el Rebir Camp. Contaller. soon after Dec loth witness saw him at the C/E Ease.
