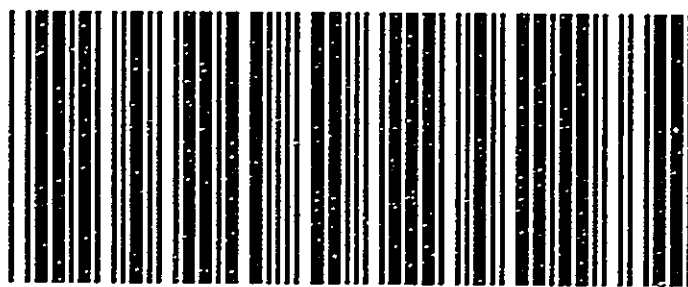

Witness knew Michell well. He was about 20 years of age, was connected with the profession of dentistry, and was member of the 3rd reinforcements of the battn. His number was about 1500. He was wounded at the landing by a bullet in the chest. Witness did not see the occurrence but Michell told him of it. Subsequently he was wounded in the neck at Lone Pine. Witness saw him at hospital Luna Park and actually saw the wound. Michell was temporarily on the staff from Aug. to Dec. 1915 and soon after Dec 15th witness saw him at the C/E Base.
