We beg to inform you that 432 Pte. Frank Edward Moir
54th. Battn. A.I.F. for whom you were enquiring is a Prisoner of
War in Germany. We learn from a German list dated 26.2.17 that
he has now been transferred to another Camp and his present address
is as follows :-

432 Pte. Frank Edward Moir,
54th. Aust. Infantry Battn.
Stammlager,
Wahn - GERMANY

Across the corner of your card or envelope write
"Kriegsgefangenensendung" - British Prisoner of War".

Cards seem to reach the prisoners more safely than
letters, and of course be careful not to make any mention of the war.

We send regularly parcels of food and clothing to all
our prisoners in Germany.

Should we receive any notification of any other changes
in his address, we shall at once advise you.
