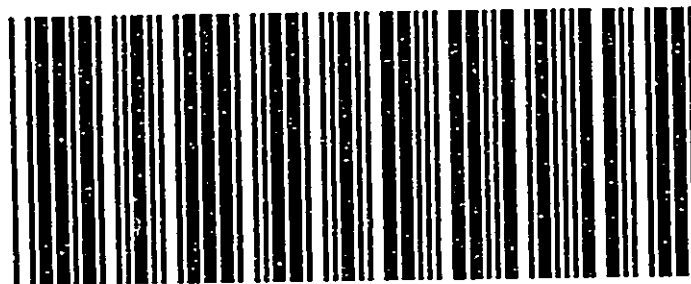

600 Pte. R.E. Marshall 7th Battalion was admitted on the 17th November 1918 with Broncho Pneumonia, and died on the 25th November 1918 at 2.45 a.m. He had a Military Funeral and was buried in the Abbeville Cemetery on the 26th November 1918. Grave 6, Row E, Plot 5.
