Informant saw Mason hit in the neck and shoulder by shrapnel on 9th May at the top of Dead Man's Gully, opposite Lone Pine. Mason was sitting in a dug-out, behind the trench, with his mate when a shell struck them both. Informant saw Mason taken away to the Dressing-Station.
