you that the only man of that name and initial on the
Headquarters list is 1536 Pte. W.S. MASON, 3rd Pioneer,
A.I.F. who died of wounds (Shrapnel) at 47th Casualty Clearing
Station on 31-5-18. He was buried in the British Cemetery
at Crouy, 16 miles north west of Amiens.

If you are satisfied that this man is your friend,
kindly let us know, and we will make enquiries as to the
details of his death and burial and forward the same to you.
