He was in A. Coy. IV. Pltn. but I cannot say where he came from in Australia. I saw his body near the railway embankment at Ballecourt on the 3rd of May. He had been killed by a shell. He was killed that night buried that night near the Railway Embankment in the same grave with 3 other men. To mark the grave a rifle with a steel hat on it, was put up.
