"Casualty was wounded at Fleurs on the 23rd November 1916. We were in the act of taking over the front line and relieving the 60th Battalion about 10 p.m. I was lying down wounded by a shell hole, when Casualty came along. He was just able to walk. He said he was wounded and he started to go back to the D.S. This is the last I saw or heard of him."
