In answer to your enquiry for :-

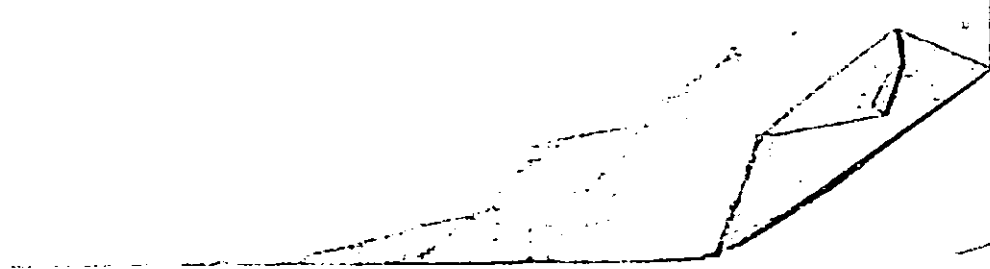
5478 Pte. H.J. Mc Gregor, 15th. Battn. A.I F
