"I know the circumstances in which Casualty became missing. Casualty went out with a raiding party in early morning on the 11th April at Bullecourt. The whole of the Platoon in which he was, No. 7 Platoon, D. Co. was cut off and none returned. We all considered they had been taken prisoners."
