Victoria Barracks. Sydney. 29-7-18.

2) No after embarkation payment made.

3) No 2383 Tpr. A. H. Penney. Aust. Prov. Corps. who states he saw Mills in France about August or September 1917. Interrogated states he has seen Mills at Albert in August 1917. He was then serving with 2nd D.A.C. and again seen at Kemell later in same year. Best of health. Religious parties not known.

No 1873. Dvr. R. G. Low. 5th D.A.C. informed father he saw Mills at Bulford Camp. Salisbury Plains. 24-7-16.

Low's statement was he knew Mills in civilian life - vouched for him.

"He marched into Bulford Camp with an Australian Artillery Rft about the date mentioned (24-7-17) I was then in Artillery Details Camp Bulford and again saw Mills on the day following and was talking to him on that day. Have not heard from him or seen him since."
