I knew him well. He lived at Kogarah, N.S.Wales, and worked as an engineer. He came over with the 22nd ~~Inf~~ 1st. On the 4th Octr we were near Messchendaele. About 6.15 a.m. we went over. Harrison was on my left, a few yards off, and had not gone far when he was hit by a shell and killed at once. His body was buried by Pioneers, so I am told, in the cemetery at Half Way House, Ypres, and it would certainly be marked.
