I saw both Walker's legs blown off at the Anzac landing by a shell. This occurred on the ridge above Pest Gully. We came up through Shrapnel Gully to this point. He must have died as the result of his injuries, which were fearful. He was a short fellow, a "hard deer." We know him as "Wakker" Walker.
