He was a mate of mine, and came from Goulburn, N.S.Wales, and was a cattle man, he came from Sydney with me in the 20th to the 19th reinforcement, we were transferred in England to the 35th. I was alongside him at the back of the Churchyard at Villers Bretonneux on the morning of the 4th April 1918, as we were retiring, when he was killed instantly by a bullet through the head and his body left behind on ground now held by the enemy.
