On this date, which Informant gave, two trenches were taken near Mouquet Farm, at about 5 a.m. The same morning, after the attack, Cpl.Pomfrey was struck by a shell (Informant believes in the head) and killed. Informant did not see the Casualty but refers for further particulars to Pte.A.J.Ccoper, 5066, M.G.S. A Coy. 49th A.I.F.

Informant states that on Sept. 3rd, 1916, at Pozieres in an advance, he was several yards behind Pomfrey and saw him fall, killed instantly by shrapnel. Informant states that he helped to bury Col. Pomfrey in the rear of the front trench. Private silliam Ingham of the same battalion ( 49th ) wrote these details to Pomfrey's mother, some days after the action.

This happened at Mokay Farm, about halfway across No Man's land.
