"Killed 24-4-18"

He was in B.Coy., and I saw him killed at Meteren, when death was instantaneous, he being hit in the head by a bullet by sniper. Casualty happened about 1 o'clock in th morning of 24-4-18, at which time he was digging in. He was a M.Gnr. I knew him fairly well, and he came from S.Australia. I did not see his grave, but he was buried behind support lines in front of Meteren, and grave was marked by a Cross having full details marked thereon. I cannot refer to anyone.

I was acting as S/B at Meteren on April 24th 1918 and I carried out his dead body. I do not know what produced death. The ground was held.

I knew Voumard. He was in my Platoon. He was killed just outside Meteren on the morning of April 24th. He was carrying machine gun pannier and when they went out to him and to get them off, he was quite dead; it was instantaneous. I was hit immediately after so cannot say about burial.
