I regret that the Chaplain attached to No 2 C.C.S. on March 9-16-18 has gone to another Unit. Pte. S.J. Thorburn 4th Pioneer Battalion, A.I.F. was admitted on 9-3-18 and died on 16-3-18 of pneumonia. The C.C.S. was at that time at Oustersteene near Bailleul and Pte Thorburn would be buried in the British Military Cemetery close at hand. There is every prospect that the place of his burial which is now in the hands front German portion will be in the hands of our own people before long. I am sorry to have to disappoint the natural desire of the relatives for personal details of Pte Thorburn's illness.

I regret that the P.M. Captain attached to No. 2. C.C.S. on March 9-16/1918 has gone to another unit. Pte S. J. THORBORN, 4 P.M. Batt. A.I.F. was admitted on 9/3/18 and died on 16/3/18 of pneumonia.

The C.C.S. was at that time at Osterbeek near Bailleul and ~~the~~ Pte Thorburn would be buried in the P.M. cemetery close at hand.

There is every prospect that the place of his burial which is now in the hands of German forces will be in the hands of our own people before long.

I am sorry to have to disappoint the natural desire of the relatives for personal details of Pte Thorburn's illness.
