Informant says:- " He was dark, of medium height, thick set and I think about 35 years. His home was at Najinup, West Australia. He was badly wounded when on a reconnaissance. The bullet entered the thigh somewhere and he was evacuated to the 14th Aust. Gen. Hospital where he died. He was very popular, lighthearted and obliging. He was in my troop. My brother who was with him when he was hit and who was also at the 14th A.G.H. when he died, has returned to Australia and would give fuller particulars to his wife, who lives not far from our home"

Informant says:- Christain name William, was married, and came from Kojouup, W.A. On the morning of 3rd. May we had been sent out to hold up the advance of Turks at a pass, but two hours after daybreak were forced to retire. In retirement he was hit thro the thigh. We carried him back to the lead horses, where he mounted and rode to Hospital in Es Salt. He then rode to Foothills and was evacuated to Jericho Hospital, and died later in the 14th. A.S.H. after a relapse."
