We were on the Fleurs front and was about 50 yards away when I saw a rifle grenade strike the Machine Gun at which he was working afterwards striking him, hitting him in the head and killing him at once. This happened during the morning. I saw his dead Body on parapet but know nothing about his burial.
Height 5ft 5" 21/22 years of age. Fair, thin face.
