Just in front of Vill-rs Bratonneux on Varch 30/10, we were going into action and about 100 yards from our tranches, he was hit through the heart. He lay where he fall for a couple of days. I do not know where he was buried.

Informant who could give no particulars of his burial described Pte O'Shea as about 6ft in height and rather heavily built, clean shaven full face and fresh complexion. He was aged about 30 and a was a Lewis Gunner.
