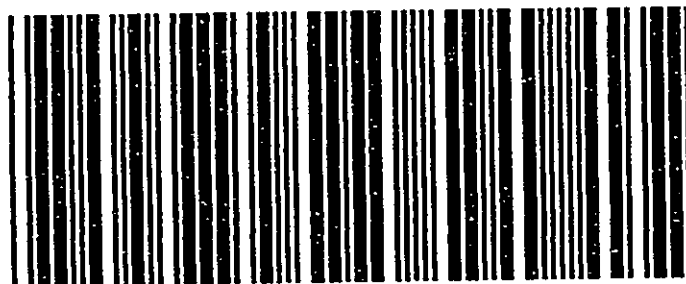

In reply to your communication of 23rd inst., regarding above named I have to inform you he was admitted to this Hospital on 7.4.17 suffering from "GSW Multiple" - Face, left Arm and Leg. He had several haemorrhages from left arm, being particularly severe on the morning of 4.5.17, which was followed by collapse from which he never recovered. He was interred in St Sever Cemetery, Rouen, on 5.5.17. Grave No.2372.
