

I helped to bury A.W. Walker whom I knew well at Herbecourt near Feronne. The Battn. cross was erected. He was buried on 3/9/18

Height - 5/4-5 dark,/not very, medium ouild, age 26-30 dame from near Sydney - was a carpenter in civilian life. On Sept. 1/18 near feronne I saw Talker sitting back against the side of the trench, He had been hit in the head with a piece of shell, and was dying at the time. He was unconscious & could not speak. I was assisting to take other wounded men away at the time and when I saw Talker later he was dead. That was the last I saw of him - he was in ay Coy.(D.)
