Witness says that Pither was shot through the heart by a machine gun, about 5 a.m. on Sunday 8.8.15 at West Hill. He was killed just in front of witness. They could not bring in the body. Witness adds that that corner was a veritable hell, and there must have been 12 or 18 bodies there.
