I know him well; he lived with me in Brighton, Adelaide, South Australia. He was a labourer, single. I saw his grave at Mault Trench, Pys, near the top of a trench, close to the Village amongst a few other graves. There was a temporary cross on it with his name written in indelible pencil on the wood. I could point it out. He was an Englishman, but joined up in South Australia. He had been in South Australia about 6 years.
