"Killed 22.7.18"

We were in front of Marris on July 24th. I was in charge of a party of 8 Stretcher bearers. We carried his body away to Battalion Aid Post just across the road from Estaminet Corner. Rendell's body was also brought in, and I covered both of them with a blanket. I cannot give details of Death and burial.

"Killed in Action 22-7-18"

It was at Merris on night of 22nd July. He had gone out with a party to take a machine gun post and was hit in the head by a machine gun bullet and killed instantly. I did not see him hit but helped to carry him in from the front line to Company Headquarters. I did not see burial or grave.

"Killed in Action 22-7-18"

I saw him at Estaminet Corner R.A.P. near Merris on 25th July three days after he was killed and saw his body sent back from there to the transport lines for burial.

"Killed in Action 22-7-18"

At Merris about midnight of 22nd July or about that date, he was in charge of a mopping up party. Whilst attempting to mop up a strong German post, he was shot through the head by a machine gun bullet and undoubtedly killed instantly. His body was brought out 3 days later and I think buried at Berre. Randell.J.C. 7061. was killed in same stunt.
