"I knew Casualty. He was a tall man, about 6 ft. medium built, fair complexion, fair moustache, known as "Owen". Casualty was waiting for the barrage to lift. An H.E. shell exploded in Casualty's dug-out killing him instantly and C. Carpenter. I was 5 yds. away at the time the shell exploded but I went immediately to Casualty's assistance and he was quite dead when I arrived there. I do not know the exact spot where Casualty was buried, but I know it was near the position where he was killed.
