"Died of wounds 5.11.17"

I saw him wounded at Passohendaele Ridge. He was caught by fragment of shell that landed in the trench which hit him about the head. He was taken away to the dressing station in an unconscious condition where I believe he died. I knew him very well, he came from Queensland and was the only man of that name in the Coy., He came away from Australia with the 17th Rfts which left there 19.4.16. I do not know place of burial and cannot refer to anyone for particulars.

Reedman was in A.IV. He was wounded about 4 o'clock one morning about the 3rd or 4th Hovember at Passchendaele Ridge on outpost duty. I and three others S/Bs went out and brought him in and took him to the R.A.P. about a mile back. He was alive but unconcious when we left him, and we heard afterwards that he died. He was a thick built man of about 22 with very black hair.

He was in D. Coy. I know him and a <u>3/Bearer Frivate S. Grand</u> told me on about November 18th that he had carried Reedman to the D/Station. He was hit by a shell; had one leg off and otherwise badly wounded on **November** 11th at Passchondacle. He died at the D/Station . Grand is in the 9th. Battalion, D. 3/Bearer. Reedman was a young lad, 5 feet 8, dark rather round faced.
