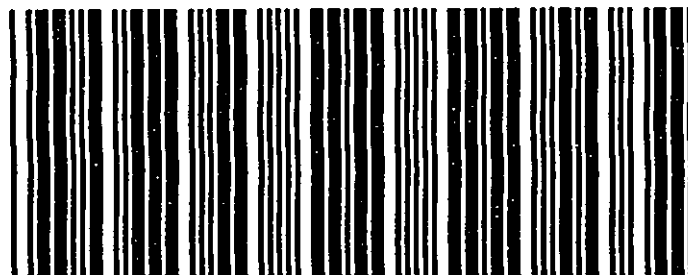

On 24th May an armistice had been arranged and informant was one of a Burial party that went into "Death-Trap Gully"-- a continuation of Shrapnel Gully. On one of the bodies buried there was a circular pocket compass, about the size of a watch, bearing the name, "A.A. Robins". The body was not capable of identification.

They came with the ^{same} ~~1st~~ ^{the 12th} rein^t., Robins was killed on 2/5/15, while sniping
at a place called Death Gully or Death Trap. He was shot through the head.
Witness was there and actually saw it. Robins was buried during the ar-
mistice.
