Was in A Company - 2 platoon - called Arthur. We were digging a new line between Villées Brettonne and Hangard, and Randall was posted as a Sentry out in front, and he lost his way coming in, and must have walked into Fritz's line and was taken prisoner. The last that was seen of him - He was standing out in front - there was no shelling at the time. We looked for him in the morning but could not find any trace of him - We could see right across to Fritz's line - and there was no body lying out. Nothing since has been heard of him.
