Witness states Randall was hit by a fragment of shell in back in No Man's Land on Nov. 5th. Lived for about an hour afterwards. Was conscious. Cannot say whether buried. Witness was alongside him in same shell hole when hit. States he should be L/Cpl not Cpl.
