I did not see Phillips.A.Company. killed September 2nd by bullet at Mont St Quentin. (Don't know where hit) He was buried in a trench where he fell. I saw the grave next morning. A cross was erected.

Phillips was a little short chap, dark, about 30 years, married man with 2 or 3 children. Left Pinkinbah on Stearns 1-8-16. He was a cousin of Sergeant Habbitt.
