

If this is Chris Wood of B.VII he was killed at Rieppe Forest where we were on the same post. He was killed about 1 p.m. on Sunday, April 14th, while Fritz was making a second attack. I saw him killed outright by a piece of shell which, I think, hit him on the forehead, and I saw his body carried out by S/Bs. I expect he got buried all right, but I got wounded later on the afternoon and cannot say further.

Berquin. We were on the same Post together, when he was killed instantaneously by a shell. He was carried away by two Stretcher Bearers, S/B. Arthur Wilson (8.B. A.M.C) and S/B. Smith (8.B) I am sorry that I do not know where he is buried".

Nood set killed by a shell. Fritz was attacking us at Sieppe Forest and he was killed about 20 yards just in front of me. I saw him after he was killed and he was buried in Rieppe Forest where I have seen his grave with a cross up over it. It is about halfway along the Vieux-Berquin and La Notte Road and stands back sone 20 yards in a wood. It is not a cemetery, but there are a lot of our Battn. buried there. This happened on April 14th. Wood was in B.Coy. VII platoon. He was an English chap and his people lived somewhere in England.

"Killed 14-4-18"

He was in B.Company. and I saw him killed at Nieppe Forest, when death was instantanceus, he being hit by a whiz hand and badly knocked on the head and bady. He was resting at the time after having been an duty all sight, and was sleeping about 50 yards away behind the authorst. This would be about 2 colock in the afternoon about 7 hours efter he came off auty. We were always mates together, so I knew him well. He came from Richmond Victoria. I saw his grave at Hieppe Forest on the field and grave was going to be marked shortly after I saw it. I saw it the day after he was buried by Chaplain Captain Booth.C.of.E. Eth Batta. who since I understand has returned to Australia.

He was of B.Company. VII Platoon. -t Materian on night of 13th April, enemy attacked our line. Was killed outright by shell, hit in head. I was almost alongside him when it happened. Was buried by pioneers in Military Cemetery at Materian. I have not seen his grave, but he was a personal friend and pioneers told re where he was buried, order created. Christian name Uris, came from Richmoni, Melbourne. Private effects were handed into Battn.H.C. Has a sister living in England.
