

He was killed Sept 20th at Dickebusch - did not see him killed but have seen his grave at a British cemetery at Dickebusch. I particularly went to visit the grave having heard he was buried there, and carefully noted the initials. He is in a grave alone and with a small cross. Should say from 30/35, I think married, about 5ft 10, broad build, and good at games.
