Pte. A. WINSOR of the 22nd battalion, D Co., 14th platoon, No. 4569, was lying alongside me in the Hop Off trench in front of the Railway Embankment at Bullecourt on the morning of May 3rd, 1917 about 3 a.m., waiting for the order to go over, when a shell exploded right against him. I called out and asked him if he was all right but got no answer, and I saw his rifle sticking up in the air. I could see the body. I did not examine it as we got the order to advance very soon after. I am certain he was killed. We did not hold the ground. I think he came from Brunswick, East Victoria, and was a tailor.
