Dear Madam.

We regret to advise you of an unofficial report confirming our worst fears as to the fate of No. 5057 Pte. A.J. Strong 16th Bttn, I.I. A.I.F..

Informant No. 1840 Sgt. A. Miller who was in the Bethnal Green Military Hospital on April 30th says that Pte. Strong was found dead, killed by concussion at Mouquet Farm and information to this effect is in the Battalion records.

Our evidence is purely unofficial and has as yet no confirmation from A.I.F. Head Quarters. We are pursuing the inquiry further and will advise you immediately on receipt of information as we fully realise your anxiety.
